4. **No alcohol is to be consumed or displayed by any parade participant. No promotional material or items of any kind can be thrown from parade entries during the course of the parade.**
5. The Scone Horse Festival Committee has the right to refuse entries.
6. Children must be supervised by appropriate number of responsible adults.
